Re: Follow-Up from CAC meeting, April 23, 2024

As a follow up to Tuesday's CAC's question and answer session meeting held on April 23, 2024, attached you will find Foundations to Freedom's (Foundations) revision to the original grant submission, per our conversation yesterday, April 25, 2024. You mentioned that you had spoken with Mr. Small, WVHA Counsel, and he approved a revision submission for review based on the points discussed at Tuesday's CAC meeting.

WVHA funds requested: \$50,400.

Identify why funds are being requested and how funds will be used:

In February 2023, Foundations began offering onsite counseling by a Licensed Mental Health Counselor and State Certified Addictions Counselors. When a client is admitted to Foundations, they meet with a clinical team member for an initial behavioral health assessment that includes a biopsychosocial assessment. The Counselor and the client develop recovery goals that support the client's mental health assessment and a care plan for the client is developed. The frequency of continued out-patient counseling is dependent upon the initial assessment and will be based on client needs. The clinical team and the client determine how many sessions will be included in the care plan; however, Foundations requires a minimum of bi-monthly meetings with the client clinician.

For the WVHA funding the breakdown for the project is as follows:

Each therapy session has a Medicaid billable expense of \$73.96 per hour. For the 2024-2025 WVHA program year for each individualized care plan, Foundations uses a baseline of two (2) counseling sessions per month per client. Foundations projects increasing our annual client base from year 2023 of 150 clients per year, to a 2024-2025 projection of 200 clients per year. This will result in a total of 4,800 counseling sessions per year [(200) (2) (12) = 4,800]; 4,800 counseling sessions at \$73.96 per session totals \$355,008. Foundations is asking for \$48,000 for billable hours. For the purposes of this resubmission, Foundations has reduced the "administrative" cost to 5%.

The job descriptions and qualifications for the positions that will be working on the WVHA grant are as follows:

** Robert Lemoine has a Certified Intervention Professional certificate from the state of Pennsylvania. This certification is recognized internationally. His certification has been verified by the Pennsylvania Certification Board. Florida does not have an equivalent certification, however, since his certification is recognized internationally, Foundations is utilizing his expertise.

Addictions Counselor:

Job Description: Provides counseling services to clients and their families that; plans in partnership with client to promote recovery wellness plan for emotional, behavioral, and system stability; provides intake biopsychosocial assessment; provides culturally sensitive psychotherapy and other outpatient mental health services to promote recovery to include individual, couple, family, and group counseling; develops individualized recovery plan with measurable goals and objectives in collaboration with the client; reviews recovery plan and makes recommendations for adjustments; completes documentation in a timely and accurate manner utilizing the agency's electronic case management system, in accordance with Federal, State, and agency guidelines; provides groups recovery groups, providing mental health and other health topics; participates in weekly case management meetings; licensed to perform EMDR therapy; maintains strict confidentiality and handle information with tact and diplomacy.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in social work, psychology, or other related mental health field; Certified Addictions Professional (CAP) or Certified Addictions Counselor (CAC) preferred; must pass level II background screening; valid driver's license; pass initial onboarding and random drug screens; minimum of 5 years of recovery from substance use disorder or other co-occurring mental health preferred; excellent communication, organizational, and written skills; proficient in Microsoft Office suite.

Licensed Mental Health Counselor:

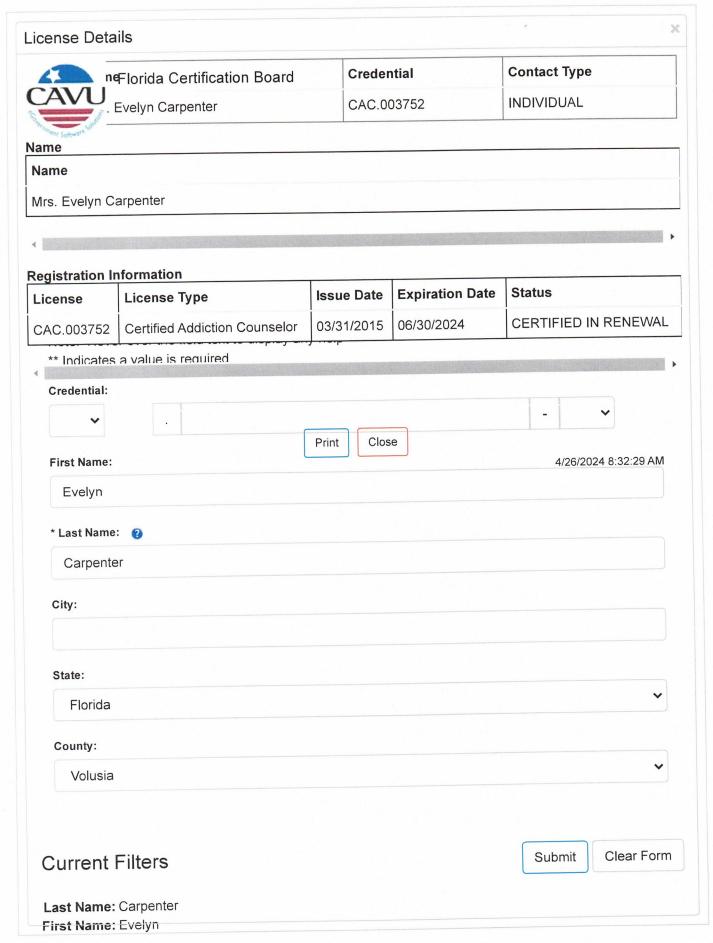
